FEBRUARY UPDATE

WHERE ARE WE AT?

- Main pool hall transparent roof and the surrounding roof cladding is now complete
- Finishing works are ongoing in the front of house area with aluminium joinery almost complete and final fixes commencing soon
- New ventilation/air conditioning is being installed to all pools and front of house
- New filtration equipment for both pools is currently being installed
- Re-lining and connection of the leisure pool to the new filtration plant has started



WHAT'S NEXT?

- Contractors have almost completed the wooden portal frame revitalisation work, which means dismantling of the main scaffolding will start soon
- Mezzanine floor works are progressing well with the overhead services complete and ceiling framework installation ongoing
- Once the scaffolding for the roof is removed, work can start on the pool hall floors and final finishes

WHAT DOES STAGE TWO OF THE REVITALISATION INCLUDE?

- A reclad of the main pool hall, including a transparent roof and a better connection to the outdoor 50m pool area
- Relining of the leisure pool and addition of poolside showers
- Remodel of the reception space and indoor changing rooms, providing more modern and accessible facilities and family friendly-spaces, and eliminating the current wind tunnel from the front entrance through to the pools
